


GIVE A DRESSER A MINI-MOLKEOVER

Here's a weekend project that anyone can do. Dress up a dresser with new paint and knobs.





GET READY Empty the contents and remove the existing drawer pulls or knobs.



SAND + PRIME

Sand the outside to create a rough surface for the paint to stick to. Then apply a coat of primer and let it dry.



PICK PRETTY PAINTS Use a fat brush or roller and let it dry between coats. For fun, paint one of the drawers with a contrasting color or pattern!



APPLY NEW HARDWARE Once the dresser is dry, screw on the
